REGULAR REPORTS

Membership, Registration & Administration:

We have sixteen new members. Event registration is trickling in. There are four registered for event one and two for event two.

There has been discussion that Motorsports.reg may be able to handle weekend membership for Chicago Region for our event pre-reg. We will have to explore this further.

Registration was just opened tonight to members only first for the Test and Tune in Grissom.

We need to work on getting our insurance for the Grissom weekend through Haggerty who is offering a 30% discount. We will need that by the end of March. We have been brokering through Razny, David will speak with him.

We should know by Wednesday from Dean about July 13th and 14th with Champaign County in Rantoul.

We cannot seem to get dates with INR we are seeking. We will continue to work on that.

Equipment, Property & Technology:

We need to know immediately if our new timing equipment will work with Axware or if there will be an issue. If we purchase Pronto it will move us right into the future. Cost \$1805.00 and \$295 a year. We did make an offer to Chicago Region if they purchased Pronto they can use our Farm Tech. Chicago Region is now looking into purchasing their own system. Chris D'Alessio will be working with the equipment for Chicago Region as well so he will be getting to know it well. They seem open to sharing so we will see how it goes. We should be fine with the antenna we have but will have to watch the range of start and finish.

Chicago Region is going to be ordering cones.

Darryl Dupre has always got us cones in the past. Minimum purchase is 200. He will look into cost.

Trailer Clean Out Day will be March 16th at 9am at Rt 66.

David will send the parameters of the TV that we want to have mounted to the side of the trailer to Darryl. We should change the oil on the generator. Tom will be looking into the generator.

Those planning to be at the trailer clean up are David, Tom, Darryl, Pete, Jeremy, and Chris. We will put an event on Facebook to let others know to see if anyone else wants to volunteer to help.

Pete will pick up a couple more collapsible wagons. He had to return the other due to parts were missing.

Schedules & Sites;

July 26th a Corvair Club will be borrowing all of our assets and two of our personnel for an event that Friday night at Pheasant Run. Dave and Tom will work together on getting truck and Tom will drop the trailer Thursday night and go back and pick up Saturday morning.

We already have Grissom set for April 27 & 28 with the 27th being Test & Tune and Autocross on the 28th. Chris Perry says to give him a few days and he will look into site for Saturday night gathering after the test and tune.

Discussed Saturday and Sunday of Labor Day weekend at Rt 66 if we lose the dragstrip side we will take speedway side. We do not want to do Monday. People have family commitments and others will be leaving for Nationals.

We proposed July 13 and 14 to invade Rantoul. The dates we noted as possible in last months minutes with INR are now void. We look like we have a seven event season but will hope to get eight. We have five dates at Rt 66, one at Peru and two at Champaign County.

Track Sprint is official at Autobahn, we have three dates. Two on North and one on South track. Track Sprints are not point events but we would like to have some fun trophies. June 22nd will start at 4:30 and go til sundown, July 20th will start at 4:30, this is day before Chicago Regions Event Four and the SubieFest so this event will draw a lot of participants. August 25th 4:30 to sundown. Will cap somewhere between 120 and 140 and will be three runs. Working at member price of \$60-\$65 and \$75 Nonmembers.

Trophies; Redos have been completed from SPS. We still have a variety of colors and sizes of t-shirts. Would like to deplete that stock and supplement with boonie hats. Chris Perry will look into pricing with SPS. We have ordered 500 3" inch round stickers with the new TSSCC logo.

Our newest sponsor, Gearhead Workspace will be hosting an Intro to Autocross workshop on March 21st, where we will basically be pushing what Chicago Region is offering with Learning Curve.
