Registration – OK. New entrants didn't know what class they were in. Bob will get a rulebook dedicated to Registration. We'll make copies of info forms, etc. Thing about whether we need a banner, bigger graphics on the trailer, more visibility for the TSSCC brand....

Tech – OK. Only appxo. 5 small glitches. One car rejected for bad wheel bearings.

Workers – OK. Need a system where course workers work 1 heat, and trailer works 2 heats.

Grid – Tolerable, but could have used the big, open space on the other side of the trailer. It was tight.

Timing & Scoring – OK.

Course – We need to plan better where grid, course, trailer goes as part of event pre-planning, not just course, especially in smaller lots. We need to make the course more fun. Reduce the quantity of decreasing rate corners. In general, it seemd like a 60 second course in a 40 second lot.
