## **REGULAR REPORTS**

### Membership, Registration & Administration;

#### Equipment, Property & Technology;

Tom will check with Darryl on status of tires on the Chicago Region trailer. He can also ask Darryl at that if he has a logo to use on the T-shirts as a sponsor or what he would like us to put on it. We do have clearance to use the SCCA trailer for Grissom. We will leave the golf cart at BDR's base camp for the weekend.

Chicago Region was planning a trailer clean up for this weekend. David will confirm with Chris if this is still on, date & time and let us know. Denise will be there to help as well as check on our t-shirt counts for trophies at Grissom and how many t-shirts we have left from Track Sprint and will sell those to Chicago for their track sprint at \$10.00 per shirt. Denise reached out to Heather Ingraham to let her know the price. This information was obtained by pulling up the invoice from when we purchased them. Tom will arrange to deliver t-shirts to Heather as well as get a pad of waivers from her. We went over the cost of the Truck Rental from Enterprise, \$305 down payment, another \$300 due at pickup for \$605.00. Includes 150 miles per day. Any additional miles are .39 per mile. It is 146 miles to Kokomo. Rough estimate of \$137.00 in fuel going down and \$105.30 coming back to leave the required amount of fuel in rental on return. Also fuel for generator. Club to advance Team Beall \$850.00 for these expenses.

We will need to use OUR TIMING EQUIPMENT & OUR PRINTER.

Tom asked if the plates are up to date on the SCCA trailer. David will ask Chris when he contacts him about the trailer clean up. Denise will make sure she is there for the trailer clean up. Depending on time Tim Raad will try to be as well.
